2024 Year in Review: Programs and Impact

This year, the Community Soup Kitchen has reached new milestones in its mission to support our neighbors. Over **80,000 meals** have been served, with families and residents in underserved neighborhoods gaining access to hot food and essential services.

65 elementary school students received meals to nourish them over weekends away from school, ensuring they did not go hungry.

Beyond meals, <u>we provided</u> more than **100 private showers**, complete with personal hygiene kits and new clothing, to individuals without access to these basic necessities.

Thank you to all who sustain us, to those who show up to give freely of themselves, and to our incredible staff who tirelessly feed the hungry, no matter the circumstances, every single day.

The Year Ahead....



Community Soup Kitchen Goals - 2025

As we conclude 2024, we are excited to look ahead to an ambitious and impactful 2025. With the support of Yale Urban Philanthropy and funding from CT Foodshare, we will launch a new software platform designed to streamline administrative operations and enhance connectivity between our guests and essential service providers. This innovative project will provide our guests with ready access to nutritional information and the ability to register for access to essential services, while volunteers can register for specific shifts and activities onsite. It will also connect guests in any of our distributed locations with services available at 84 Broadway, and enable CSK staff to automate operational data management. More about this project will be unveiled in our next newsletter, and we can't wait to share more details with you.

Our goals for 2025 include <u>expanding meal services</u> to two <u>additional neighborhoods</u>, <u>meeting 10% of the local meal gap in each</u>, <u>and serving an additional 20,000 meals</u>. We also aim to sustain and grow our existing programs in Downtown and Newhallville, continuing to deliver critical services to our community.

Our Appeal: Help Us Feed New Haven

This year, CSK served over 80,000 meals, a testament to the resilience of our team and the generosity of our supporters. Despite this success, the need in New Haven remains staggering, with over 32,000 residents facing food insecurity and a meal gap of 4.5 million meals annually.

With your help, we have become a critical part of the solution, providing nutritious meals for just \$0.77 per meal. Our recent expansion into Newhallville, where we now serve over 200 meals daily, has proven the effectiveness of our scalable and impactful model. Looking ahead, our 2025 goals are ambitious but achievable. To meet these objectives, we must raise funds to support the setup and infrastructure for new locations while sustaining our current programs.
