In fulfilling our mission to 'feed the hungry, no matter the circumstances', as of July 31st CSK has served 45,380 meals, an increase of 12% through the same time in 2023.

While we solemnly acknowledge the rising levels of food insecurity throughout the community we serve, we also remain inspired by our ability to continually grow to meet the needs of our guests as efficiently as we can given the resources available to us.

In response to these changing dynamics across the city of New Haven and in pursuit of our vision to see that 'each and every individual has access to food, health services, and community engagement in a dignified and mutually respectful environment', in this newsletter we are proud to update you on three new programs that were launched in the first half of the year.

Childhood Hunger Initiative

In April, CSK partnered with Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Tau Xi Omega Chapter (TXO), to support their Childhood Hunger Initiative Power Pack (CHIPP m), purchasing, storing and packing meals for food insecure students of the Helen Street Elementary School.

Each Friday during the school year volunteers packed, and CSK delivered, 65 backpacks. Each pack contains 4 full meals plus healthy snacks, allowing those children to remain fed over the weekend, until school meals become available again during the week.

Newhallville Lunch Program

During May, and in conjunction with The V.I.L.L.E.G.E. and Mt. Calvary Outreach Center, we began serving meals from a fully-staffed satellite location at 5 Hazel Street in Newhallville. As many residents of New Haven know, Newhallville suffers at a disproportionate rate of poverty and food insecurity.

CSK is blessed to have the kitchen staff, food and kitchen capacity to produce a high volume of meals. We are also lucky to have the delivery capabilities that allow us to get those meals to the neighborhoods where they are needed, such as Newhallville.

Our meal service there has grown from 40 to nearly 200 meals per day in July, with those meals feeding both individuals and neighborhood families. We are indebted to the donors whose directed contributions allowed us to purchase a refrigerator, microwave, service utilities and a tent to make this program possible.







CSK Public Shower Program

In July, thanks to the leadership of Father Stephen Holton, the extreme generosity of everyone at Christ Church, and the persistence of one of our most treasured volunteers, Francine Jaworowicz, we were able to launch the CSK Public Shower Program.

On Tuesdays and Thursdays between 8:30 and noon, anyone in need can register for private showers in the newly renovated area at Christ Church. Guests who register for showers also receive personal toiletry bags, fresh t-shirts and socks upon departing.

We look forward to the continued growth and success of this program, working in conjunction with agencies across the city that have expressed their appreciation for its existence as an essential resource for those in need.
